TA Training: Supporting pupils with SEND

Thursday 17 October 2024 | 0930 – 1500 | Countess Wear Community School, Exeter

This training will seek to build understanding of the duties and responsibilities schools face to uphold the SEND Code of Practice. We will look together at the national picture, focusing down on the use of the Devon Graduated Response Toolkit to consider how this can support us in our day-to-day.

We will look at the workings of a pupil's brain and spend time reflecting on how the fight, flight or freeze response can be supported by trusted adults. We will consider the power of building positive relationships, being specific in our praise and looking to promote resilience for the pupils who have barriers to their learning. We will also consider the value and importance of how we can keep our own mental health healthy.

AQA Writing for GCSE English Language Paper 1 & 2 | Stretching Grade 3 to 4

Tuesday 5 November 2024 | 1000 - 1500 | Oldway Primary School

This is an AQA course which will be delivered by experienced lead examiner Lance Hanson.

The focus of the day will be on writing and the knowledge and skills required for success in both GCSE English Language papers. We will address some more general concepts in the morning, looking at the typical features of writing demonstrated by students at all levels of the mark scheme. In the afternoon, we will use the 'GCSE English Language Stretching Grade 3 to 4' course as a springboard to look more specifically at some granular approaches to writing.

We will also explore the typical features of writing for GCSE English Language Paper 1 and Paper 2. We will consider how an understanding of these typical features can help us to support student progress and plan a writing curriculum.

This course will consider ways in which students attained grade 4 in the Summer 2023 series. Exemplar responses from the summer exams will be explored to highlight key skills for success. It will provide practical classroom approaches to help with your confidence, knowledge and expertise to improve your students' ability.

- focus on skills that students can use to improve performance in the writing questions
- explore how students cover AOs in exemplar writing responses
- provide you with a range of classroom activities to maximise your students' potential

Two Day Paediatric First Aid

Tuesday 19 & Wednesday 20 November 2024 | 0930 - 1600 | Countess Wear Community School, Exeter

This qualification is designed for workers caring for children in the absence of their parents and meets Ofsted requirements for those working in Early Years settings. Currently the EYFS statutory framework requires at least one person who has a current paediatric First Aid certificate to be on the premises or outings at all times, when children are present.

This qualification is designed to provide essential paediatric lifesaving skills and paediatric incident management. Typical delivery methods are predominantly practical, and the course is assessed by continual observation of candidate performance.

Cost: £155 per person for SWIFT member schools (includes lunch and e-certificate) | £220 per person for non-member schools (includes lunch and e-certificate).
