## About SWIFT Curriculum Forum

The SWIFT Curriculum Forum brings together curriculum leaders that have responsibility for building curriculums in schools and trusts. Curriculum Forums are termly events that cover four aspects of curriculum:

1. Design: exploring models and approaches to curriculum design, including the implications of Cognitive Science

2. Content: exploring approaches to prioritising curriculum knowledge and content

**3.** Equality, Diversity and Inclusion: exploring how leaders ensure these values are enshrined across curriculum development

4. Leadership: implementation, inspection and beyond.

Forums are split into **Part A** and **Part C** which features keynotes speakers and is relevant to all schools and **Part B** where delegates can choose to attend a range of workshops on offer.
