## Algebra in the Primary Classroom

**A Colyton Foundation CPD Event**  
**Wednesday 5 June 2024 | 1000 - 1430**

**Target audience:**

Primary school maths teachers. No previous experience of teaching algebra necessary!

**Aims:**

- Develop maths subject knowledge and confidence.
- Help teachers stretch and challenge the most able students.
- Focus on algebra with a low floor, high ceiling approach.

The course will begin by exploring links between the Fibonacci sequence and algebra, using calculators to explore the golden ratio with simple numbers. We will progress to algebra in the context of sequences and culminate with an exploration of the application of algebra in other areas of maths, and links to other subjects in the primary curriculum.

**Programme Presenter**

Steffi Hudson has taught Maths at Colyton Grammar School Since 2005. She leads the school's maths primary outreach programme, working with over 20 primary schools, and focusing on challenging high attainers and working with primary and secondary teachers to develop cross-phase knowledge and understanding. She has led primary Maths CPD in English and German.
