Introduction

Leverage Leadership (LL) is a highly respected framework among School Leaders.

Many of the most successful Schools and Trusts today owe something to its principles. The newly created DfE Exemplary Leadership Programme led by STAR Academies along with Dixons, Outwood Grange and Inspirations Trusts has LL at its core (see [here](#)).

Key Aims

- This SWIFT Leadership Leverage in Action programme takes key Leverage Leadership approaches and provides Headteachers and senior leaders with a framework that will enable them to implement their own vision, values and culture into their school.
- The Leverage Leadership approach is modelled through the lens of 'Culture and Behaviour' and 'Observation, Feedback and Coaching.' However, the approach can be applied to any aspect of school leadership.

Key Features

- Two face-to-face days.
- Explores the 7 Levers of Leverage Leadership.
- Each day will be built around the 'See It, Name It, Do it' approach and applied to the context of that day's theme.
- Expert inputs from practising leaders that have used LL principles to improve significantly pupil outcomes, behaviour, and culture in their school.
- School walkarounds on each day.
- **Venues:** West Exe School and Torquay Academy.

The programme is for primary and secondary schools. To maximise the benefit from this course, we ask the Headteacher to attend both days with a senior leader who has responsibility for the day's theme.
