# Cohort 2b | Spring 2023 Application Window Open | Fully Funded Scholarships

Over 1100 Programme Members across the South West are currently engaging on the current cohort of newly reformed NPQs delivered in partnership with the <u>South West Institute for Teaching</u> (SWIFT), Leading Schools South West (LSSW) and Teach First.

We are proud to report that the new NPQs are proving highly successful, with 99% of participants rating the overall NPQ programme experience and learning as 4.72 stars out of 5 stars in recent Conference evaluations. The support from the DfE for NPQs as part of the professional entitlement for all teachers was validated in the Schools White Paper and full scholarships remain in place for all state-funded schools. School SLT are now building entitlement to NPQs into their annual performance management discussions, and we are pleased to announce that the application window for Cohort 2b, starting in the Spring term, is now open.

All NPQs are taught through a blended balance of online individual learning, online seminars, and our highly successful face-to-face conferences. They are designed in recognition that leaders and teachers are already busy people, with a simplified end-of-course assessment.
