His reputation was forged as Founding Principal of Dixons Trinity Academy in Bradford which became, in January 2014, the first secondary free school to be judged Outstanding by Ofsted. Luke's influential expertise in school culture is shared through his work as a Board Member with CST, Teach First's National School Forum and Ambition Institute's Schools Advisory Group.
