About the Programme

This programme will support teachers in their second year of teaching (RQTs / Year 2 ECTs) in continuing to build on an excellent start to their career. This year's programme has been planned specifically to ensure that sessions help to support teachers who have experienced disruption to their first year due to the COVID-19 situation.

The programme has been organised into core themes and will be delivered through a series of twilight sessions. We are aiming (numbers permitting) to deliver session 2,4 and 5 in groups according to the subject/phase specialism of the teacher and will seek to exemplify key standards outlined in the Early Career Framework by providing related practical strategies that can be easily applied in the classroom. These sessions will be led by experienced facilitators in their field. The programme is designed to be responsive to the needs of a teacher who is in the early stages of their teaching career.
