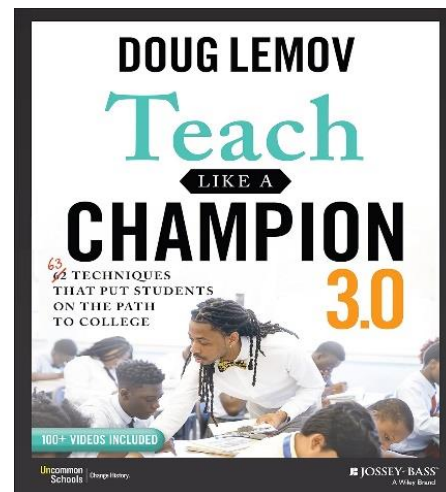


## Teach Like a Champion (TLAC)

The outcome of the 'Building Strong Classroom Cultures' training programme is to build school cultures and practices that enable joy and academic achievement for our learners. Participants will master key skills in creating classrooms with strong cultures and therefore rigorous and engaging academic instruction to thrive.

In this Train-the-Trainer model, the team of expert TLAC trainers will prepare instructional leaders to deliver training on TLAC techniques back in their schools, with a focus on high-impact behavioural and cultural techniques from *Teach Like A Champion 3.0*. Throughout the training, attendees have opportunities to reflect and plan how they might turnkey specific content and practice, as they experience a model for PD delivery they can use back in their own organisations. The training provides educators with a set of techniques, a shared vocabulary, and a framework for practice that equip teachers to achieve dramatic results with their students.

#### Training sessions and Implementation
